This is one of the fundamental systems which a language is considered to comprise, like its syntax, its morphology and its vocabulary. Phonology is often distinguished from phonetics.

1. Phonetics vs. phonology. Phonetics deals with the production of speech sounds by humans, often without prior knowledge of the language being spoken. Phonology is about patterns of sounds, especially different patterns of sounds in different languages, or within each language, different patterns of sounds in different positions in words etc.

Phonetics vs. Phonology - University of Oxford

Phonetics is the science concerned with the study of the sound system in the human language in general. Phonology, however, is the science concerned with the study of the sound system in particular languages.
